Tidal Enterprise Scheduler captures job output which is normally viewable in job activity. There are instances where the output might need to be passed to another job.

The job output is visible only to the job which created the output.

Status

Normal Operation

Resolution

Job output that contains less than 2000 characters can be passed directly to a dependent job as a variable.

1. Open the Job with which to capture the output.
2. Open the Dependency tab and click **Add**.
3. From Job/Group select the job with the output to be captured.
4. Open the Program tab, click **Variables, Job Variables**, select the parent job, then select **Job Output**.
