Insights

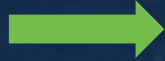
Increasing connections and greater visibility generate insights that can help identify action and automation

Action

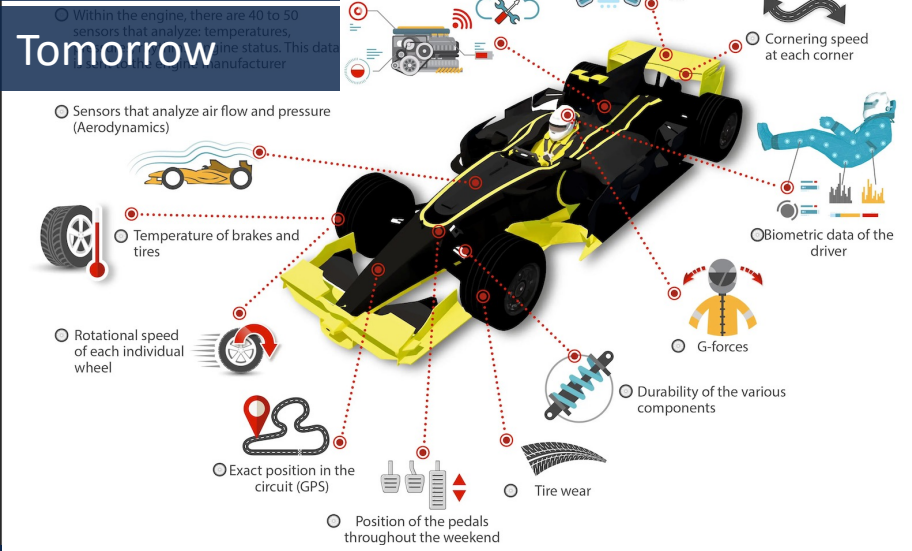

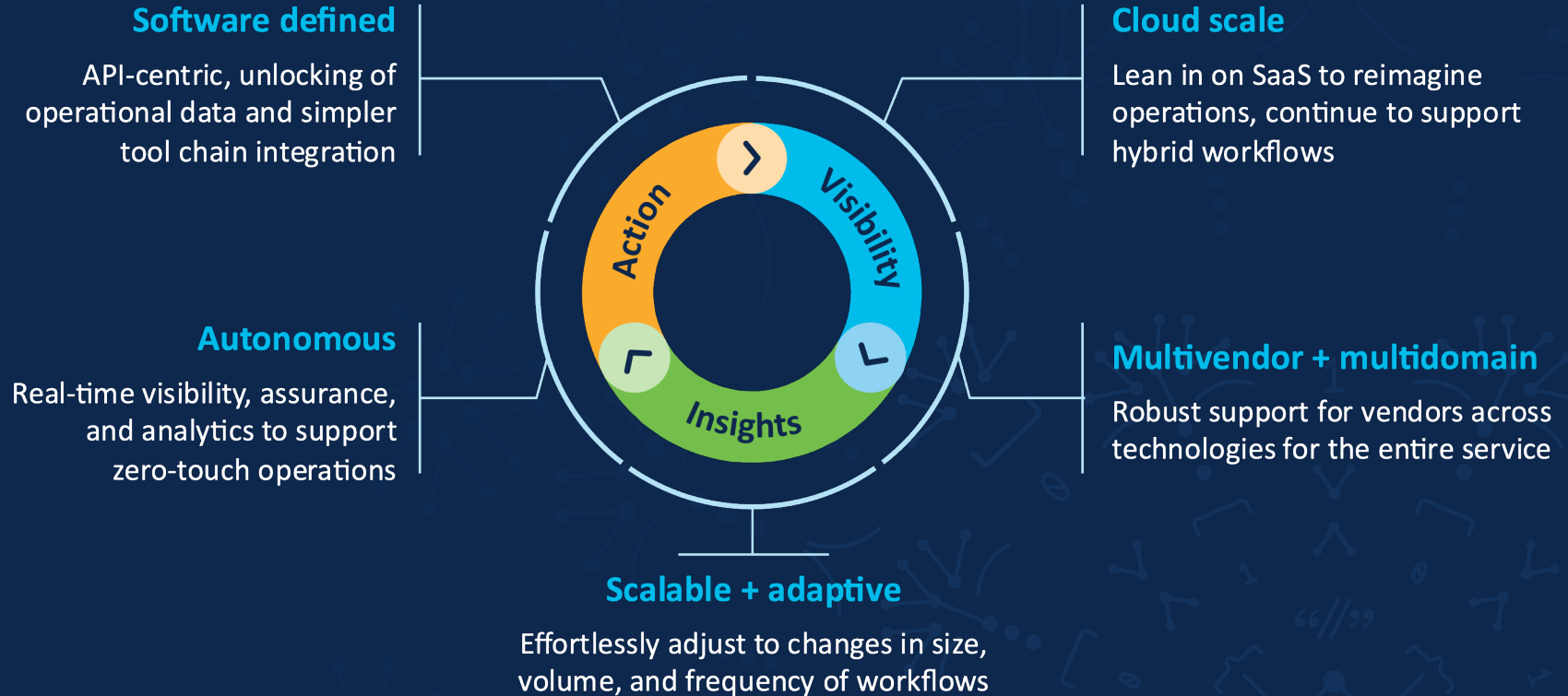
