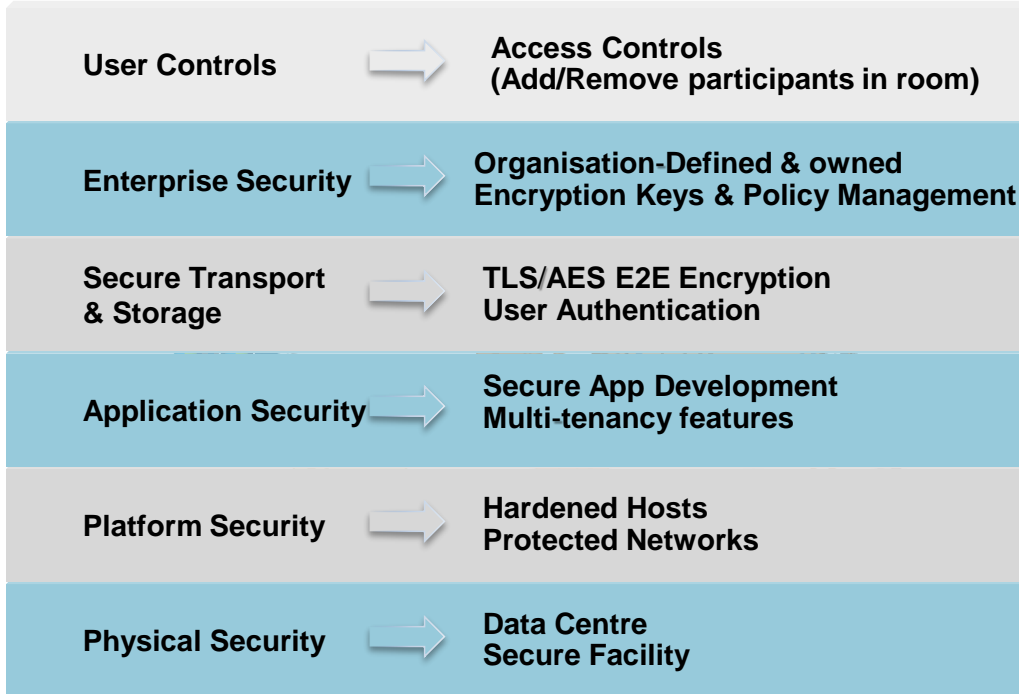


Cisco Collaboration Cloud Security - Overall Approach

- Obfuscation of user identity as widely as possible
- End-to-end encryption of messages and content
- Granular access control
- Flexibility of data storage locations

Enterprise Grade Security – High Level

Data in motion encryption:

Encrypted signalling audio/video

HTTPS

Encrypted Media (sRTP/SRTP-EKT)

Data at rest (Persistent Storage)

Separate DB Stores KMS/Content

Enterprise Grade Security – Key Rotation

- Key Management Server (KMS) manages keys.
- Signed ephemeral Elliptic curve Diffie–Hellman key exchange between client and KMS.
- KMS generates conversation keys and distributes them to conversation parties.
- Parties encrypt all payloads using AES-256. *(envelope is unencrypted)*
- “Squared” servers route based on the envelope.
- “Squared” servers archive everything *(in encrypted form)*

Single shared media port deployment with “ICE”

Use single port #33434 which is within existing dynamic range customers have enabled.

Media/Share go through that port. Tries UDP and falls back to TCP if needed.

Mapping Users in AD via Directory Connector

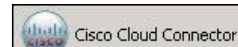

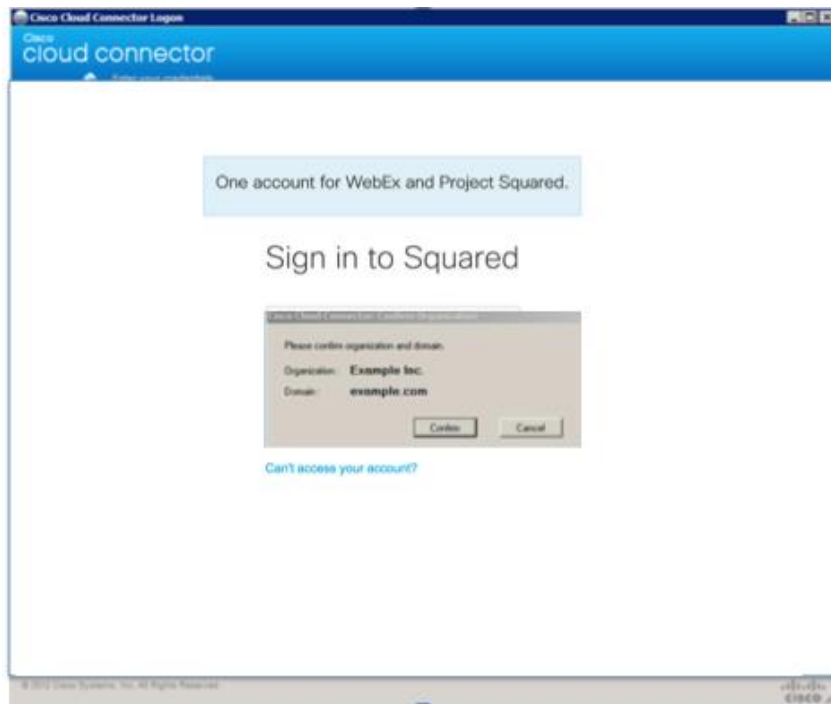


- Infrastructure for premise directory synchronisation to Common Identity cloud services (CIS)
