## Download Script/Prompt

<b>HTTP Method</b>	GET
<b>URI</b>	<code>http://&lt;server&gt;/adminapi/ResourceName/download/{FilePath}</code> Where "ResourceName" is the "script/prompt" and FilePath is a fully qualified name of the file.
<b>Example URI</b>	<code>http://uccx-server:8080/adminapi/prompt/download/default/beep.wav</code> <code>http://uccx-server:8080/adminapi/script/download/default/iod_hkqpt.aef</code>
<b>Content Type</b>	Application/XML
<b>HTTP Success Code</b>	200
<b>HTTP Failure Codes</b>	401, 402, 405, 500
<b>Error Codes</b>	—

As stated [here](#) in your supportforums thread I am unable to download scripts nor documents even though it works well when it comes to prompts.

I would be curious to know if the information contained in the Dev Guide is correct.

Ok so after many tests I was able to successfully download a script.

From what I can tell, the URL needs somehow to be different from a prompt download even if the developers guide tells the contrary:

- The "**default**" keyword in the developers guide URL **MUST** be written even though it is not the case for a prompt download.
- The keyword **MUST** be preceded by a double slash: `"/"`
- The path to the file has to be added after the keyword.

UCCX Script download through Rest API

So for example if I want to download the **Service.aef** script mentioned above, the URL must be:

[http://server\\_IP/adminapi/script/download//default/Site/Service.aef](http://server_IP/adminapi/script/download//default/Site/Service.aef)

Instead of:

[http://server\\_IP/adminapi/script/download/Site/Service.aef](http://server_IP/adminapi/script/download/Site/Service.aef)

I think the developers guide needs to be updated to reflect this.

As for a document download, unfortunately it seems to be unavailable using the REST API.

Any comment appreciated on this!

Did you try to use the UCCX REST API for DELETE prompts in the UCCX Server. We are running version 11.

I'm getting the following error:
