



## Instruction for Getting Evaluation License Key for Cisco's Cloud Services Router (CSR1000V)

Prior to Release 3.13, CSRs came with a built-on evaluation license, whereby customers would be able to use the Premium Technology Package at a maximum throughput of 50 Mbps for 60 days. With Release 3.13, we moved to a self-service model to provide customers the flexibility of trialing additional technology packages and higher throughputs. Below are the 60-day licenses that customers can get with first release of demo portal:

1. AX Technology Package, 50 Mbps Throughput (formerly known as Premium)
2. AppX Technology Package, Maximum Throughput (new Technology Package)


Our plan is to automate export compliance so that we can customers can automatically get 60-day eval license for higher throughputs of AX Technology Package from this portal.

**Below are instructions on how to get 60-day eval license:**

1. Go to [www.cisco.com/go/license](http://www.cisco.com/go/license) and log in
2. Go to "Product License Registration"
3. Click on "continue to product license registration"
4. Click on "get other licenses", a drop down menu will show up. Select "demo and evaluation".
5. Click on "router and switches"
6. Choose "Cisco cloud service route 1000V" and click "next"
7. Type the udi number which can be found from your router by typing "show license udi" and then generate the license



## Step 1: Log In



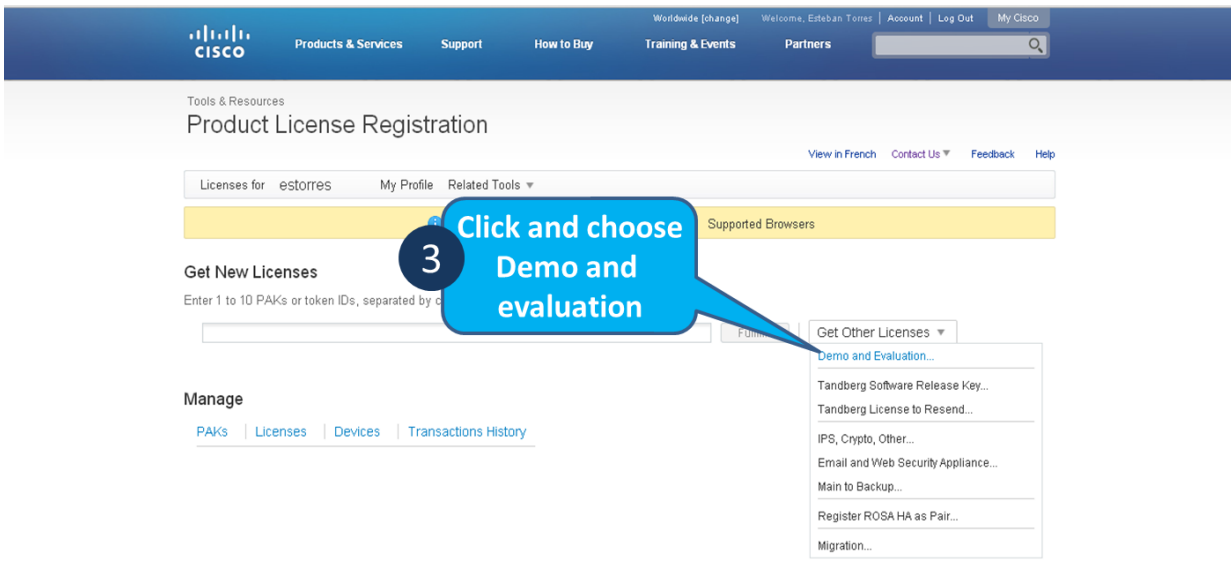

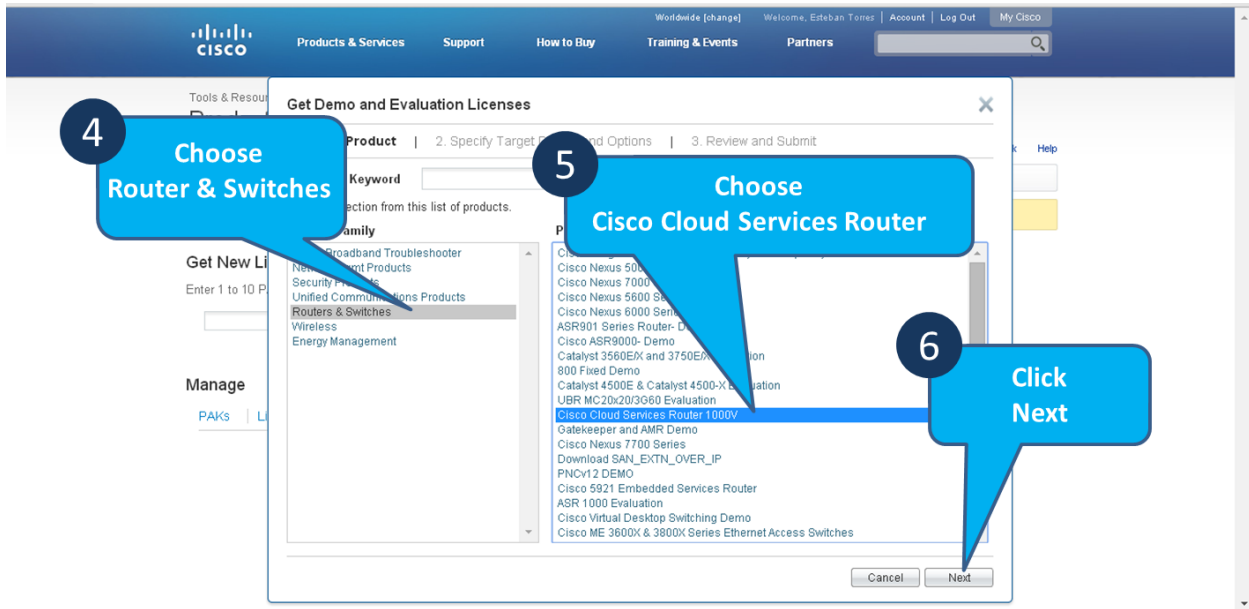
